HIV and STD Criminal Laws During the early years of the HIV epidemic, many states implemented HIV-specific criminal exposure laws (statutes and regulations). Some of these state laws criminalize behaviors that cannot transmit HIV and apply regardless of actual transmission. As of 2020, 37 states have laws that criminalize HIV exposure.
