1) induce anaesthesia with i.m. ketamine (5-10mg/kg) + atropine (20mcg/kg) + diazepam (0.1mg/kg) these may all be mixed in the same syringe. Onset of anaesthesia will start about 5 minutes after injection. The disadvantage of this technique is that it requires a relatively large i.m. injection.

Avoid general anaesthesia unless absolutely necessary for standard indications. Donning 'airborne-precaution' personal protective equipment should be considered for emergency cases because of the risk of failed neuraxial block and the consequent need for conversion to general anaesthesia and intubation (an aerosol-generating procedure).
