Autoguiding a Telescope for Deep Sky Astrophotography ...

A guide scope (sometimes spelled guidescope) is a small refractor, typically mounted on top of, or beside, the main imaging telescope. A separate camera (known as a guide camera) attaches to the guidescope, and, using software, tracks a star (known as a guide star) and sends corrective commands to the mount to ensure the star does not drift.
