The endocrine system is a collection of glands that secrete chemical messages we call hormones. These signals are passed through the blood to arrive at a target organ, which has cells possessing the appropriate receptor. Exocrine glands (not part of the endocrine system) secrete products that are passed outside the body.

The endocrine system is a collection of ductless glands that produce hormones and secrete them into the circulatory system. Endocrine glands work without ducts for carrying secretions towards target organs. Instead, hormones can act as chemical messengers for a large number of cells and tissues simultaneously.

A pair of testes is situated in the scrotum of male. The connective tissue present between the seminiferous tubules in a testis contains small clusters of endocrine cells called interstitial cells or Leydig's cells. These cells secrete various male sex hormones called androgens. The principal androgen is testosterone.

The Endocrine System

The human endocrine system is composed of endocrine glands. An endocrine gland is an organ that secretes a hormone directly into the bloodstream. A hormone is a chemical messenger secreted by an endocrine gland directly into the bloodstream where it travels to a target organ/tissue where it exerts a specific effect.
