ABNORMAL BEHAVIOR – Behavior that deviates in form, frequency, or sequence from a defined standard. AGGRESSION – Purposeful action with actual or potential result of harming, limiting, intimidating, instilling fear or submission, etc. ALPHA ANIMAL – The animal that ranks highest in its social group.
