Orbital diseases result in alterations in orbital volume, which typically leads to some degree of exophthalmos (increased orbital volume) or enophthalmos (decreased orbital volume). 5 Exophthalmos is the most common presentation associated with space-occupying masses or abscesses. The 2 main presentations of retrobulbar swelling are intraconal and extraconal, the latter being more common.
