### **Decisions about life and death: assessing the Law Reform ...**

Euthanasia is the act of deliberately ending a person's life to relieve suffering. For example, it could be considered euthanasia if a doctor deliberately gave a patient with a terminal illness a drug they do not otherwise need, such as an overdose of sedatives or muscle relaxant, with the sole aim of ending their life. Assisted suicide is the act of deliberately assisting another person to kill themselves.

### **Euthanasia and assisted suicide - NHS**

In Myers v. Schneiderman, 2016 NY Slip Op 03457 (decided on May 3, 2016), the First Department was called upon to decide whether or not the relevant provisions of the Penal Law are applicable to “assisted suicide” also called “aid-in-dying”. The Court summarized the legal background: Nearly 20 years ago, the United States Supreme Court [in Vacco v.

### **Is “Aid-In-Dying”/Assisted Suicide Legal In New York ...**

- Unitarian Universalist Association of Congregations passes a national resolution favoring aid in dying for the terminally ill, becoming the first religious body to affirm a right to die. 1990S 1990
- Washington Initiative 119 is filed, the first state voter referendum on the issue of voluntary euthanasia and physician-assisted suicide.
