Unlike a deduction, which lowers your taxable income, a tax credit directly reduces your tax bill. The 2017 federal tax law expanded the Child Tax Credit (CTC) to allow taxpayers to claim up to \$500 as a nonrefundable "Credit for Other Dependents," including elderly parents.

Child Tax Credit: You're already claiming Child Tax Credit ...

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(A) The child's parent or guardian, unless the care is provided in a certified or registered child care facility; or (B) A person who has a relationship to the taxpayer that is described in section 152(a) of the Internal Revenue Code who has not yet attained 19 years of age at the close of the tax year.
