Sentence Fragments and Run-on Sentences A sentence is a group of words that names something and makes a statement about what is named. A sentence fragment is an incomplete sentence because it lacks a subject, lacks a verb, or is a dependent clause. Fragments usually begin with a subordinate conjunction or a relative pronoun.

Sentence Fragments and Run-on Sentences

Being able to find the main subject, the main verb, and the complete thought is the first trick to learn for identifying fragments and run-ons. Sentence fragments. A sentence fragment is an incomplete sentence. Some fragments are incomplete because they lack either a subject or a verb, or both. The fragments that most students have trouble with, however, are dependent clauses—they have a subject and a verb, so they look like complete sentences, but they don't express a complete thought.

One common type of run-on sentence is a comma splice. A comma splice occurs when two independent clauses are joined with just a comma. Example of a comma splice: Participants could leave the study at any time, they needed to indicate their preference. Sentence 1: Participants could leave the study at any time. Sentence 2: They needed to indicate their preference.

Fragments, Run-Ons, and Comma Splices. 1. Non- Sentences. Run-Ons. A run-on sentence, also known as a fused sentence, occurs when two or more independent clauses are joined with incorrect punctuation or wording. In other words, run- ons occur when two or more sentences are crammed into one. Run- ons can be confusing , and because of the syntax of run -ons, readers might not read run -ons with the proper pace or emphasis.

Run-on Sentences, Comma Splices and Fragments

In order to be a sentence, a group of words must contain both a subject and a verb, and express a complete thought. A fragment is a group of words that does not express a complete thought, but is still punctuated like a sentence. A run-on sentence is two or more complete sentences that are punctuated as one long sentence.
