Freire insisted that the function of education was to build on the language, experiences and skills of the 'educatees', rather than imposing on them the culture of the 'educators'. Freire took education out of the classroom and created 'the culture circle', where learners used their own ways of speaking to articulate their shared understanding of how their world came to be like it was and how to act to change their future.
