The term "genetic engineering" was first coined by Jack Williamson in his science fiction novel *Dragon's Island*, published in 1951 - one year before DNA's role in heredity was confirmed by Alfred Hershey and Martha Chase, and two years before James Watson and Francis Crick showed that the DNA molecule has a double-helix structure - though the general concept of direct genetic manipulation was explored in rudimentary form in Stanley G. Weinbaum's 1936 science fiction story *Proteus Island*.
