Points to ponder for cargo securing manual : "Cargo Securing Devices" is all fixed and portable devices used to secure and support cargo units. "Maximum Securing Load" (MSL) is a term used to define the allowable load capacity for a device used to secure cargo to a ship. "Safe Working Load" (SWL) may be substituted for MSL for securing purposes, provided this is equal to or exceeds the strength defined by MSL.

All vessels carrying cargoes that need to be secured should carry a Cargo Securing Manual. Scope of this plan is to provide guidance on cargo units, including containers stowage and securing throughout the voyage. Plan is developed in line with IMO guidelines and requirements.

- Secure the cargo in such a way that it cannot shove away, roll-over, wander because of vibrations, fall off the vehicle or make the vehicle tip over.
- Determine the securing method(s) best adapted to the characteristics of the cargo (locking, blocking, direct lashing, top-over lashing or combinations of these).

Definitions of Cargo securing manual: Maximum securing load (MSL) is the allowable load capacity for a device used to secure Cargo to a ship.
