During Okra production, harvested crop should be stored between 45 to 50°F & relative humidity 90 to 95 percent for best results and to avoid deterioration in marketable quality. Perforated bags and 5 to 10 percent carbon dioxide can increase shelf-life 1 week.

A well-drained, fertile soil is best for okra production. Select a soil with good water holding capacity. Do not plant on very light, sandy soils. Soils that are poorly drained or known to have hardpans should not be planted to okra.

When to Plant Okra. You can start okra seeds indoors in peat pots under full light 3 to 4 weeks before the last spring frost date.; In warmer areas, you can also start okra directly in your garden 3 to 4 weeks before the last spring frost date as long as you cover the plants with a cold frame or grow tunnel until the weather warms up fully. Make sure that the covering is 2 to 3 feet tall so ...
