If you're writing a lab report for a science class and find that you need to quote or paraphrase information from another source, it's important to cite the source properly. You must cite basic information about the source within the text to let the reader know that you're borrowing from the another author's work.

### **How to Cite References in a Lab Report | Pen and the Pad**

If the lab manual was created by a staff member or department of the school and is only available through class, cite it as an unpublished work. The rules for in-text citations will be the same. If a department prepared the manual, use it for the name in the citation. For the works cited page of an unpublished manual, you can follow this format.

### **How do I cite a science lab manual for a report? - Ask Us!**

When using APA format, follow the author-date method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the year of publication for the source should appear in the text, for example, (Jones, 1998), and a complete reference should appear in the reference list at the end of the paper.

### **In-Text Citations: The Basics // Purdue Writing Lab**

Cite the information as you normally would for the work you are quoting. (The first example below is from a newspaper article; the second is from a scholarly journal.) In brackets, write "Review of the book" and give the title of the reviewed work. Provide the web address after the words "Retrieved from," if the review is freely available to anyone.

### **Reference List: Electronic Sources // Purdue Writing Lab**

If the report is presented with a report number like this, it is included in the reference within parentheses right after the title. In addition, there are multiple government agencies responsible for the report in addition to the individual authors.

### **Cite a Report in APA With This Easy Guide**

If the lab manual was created by a staff member or department of the school and is only available through the class, cite it as an unpublished work. If a department prepared the manual, use it for the name in the citation. Here are the basics: Author's Last Name, First Name (or Department name if no author).

When you cite a work that appears inside a larger source (for instance, an article in a periodical or an essay in a collection), cite the author of the internal source (i.e., the article or essay). For example, to cite Albert Einstein's article "A Brief Outline of the Theory of Relativity," which was published in Nature in 1921, you might write something like this:

When deciding how to cite your source, start by consulting the list of core elements. These are the general pieces of information that MLA suggests including in each Works Cited entry. In your citation, the elements should be listed in the following order:

### **Citations and References: Documenting your Sources**

Close with the direct URL of the web page. Copy the full direct URL or permalink of the content you want to cite. Type the words "Retrieved from," then past the URL into your entry. Do not place a period at the end of the URL.

Provide the author of the work, the title of the posting in quotation marks, the web site name in italics, the publisher, and the posting date. Follow with the date of access. Include screen names as author names when author name is not known. If both names are known, place the author's name in brackets.

### **MLA Works Cited: Electronic Sources // Purdue Writing Lab**

To cite paraphrased material in the text of your paper, put the author's last name in parentheses at the end of the sentence where the paraphrase appears. Place a comma after the author's name, then type the year the source was published. Place the period ending the sentence after the closing parentheses mark.
