Once your editor opens the file you want to enter the following information... `nameserver xxx.xxx.xxx.xxx`(enter your dns server ip) `nameserver xxx.xxx.xxx.xxx`(enter your alt dns server ip) If you use "nano" editor, type `Ctrl+x` to save changes.

Linux Basics - Set a Static IP on Ubuntu

In "IPv4" Method" section, select "Manual" and enter your static IP address, Netmask and Gateway. Once done, click on the "Apply" button. Now that you have set up a static IP Address, open your terminal either by using the `Ctrl+Alt+T` keyboard shortcut or by clicking on the terminal icon and verify the changes by typing:
