Writing a clear primary question that specifies the key components of the research plan is an essential initial step in all clinical research projects. The main advantage is that it makes the investigator think about, and write down, the key factors that will define the study: who is being studied,

what are they being exposed to (treatments or risk factors), and how are you going to measure the outcome?
