In-Text Citations: Citations are placed in the context of discussion using the author's last name and date of publication. When a work has no identified author, cite in text the first few words of the article title using double quotation marks, "headline-style" capitalization, and the year. Article in a Newspaper Cite a newspaper article as you would a magazine article, but note the different pagination in most newspapers. If there is more than one edition available for that date (as in an early and late edition of a newspaper), identify the edition after the newspaper title.

In-Text Citations As with other source types, an MLA citation for a newspaper article should include the author's surname and a page number for the specific part of the text cited: We discovered the artifact on an island in the Aegean Sea (Jones 32). Using In-text Citation Include an in-text citation when you refer to, summarize, paraphrase, or quote from another source. For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005).

If you paraphrase the information, the format of the citation of an APA newspaper article in text will be the same for printed and online version. For example: (Grady, 2016) or (Grady, n.d.).

In-text citations for print sources with known author For print sources like books, magazines, scholarly journal articles, and newspapers, provide a signal word or phrase (usually the author's last name) and a page number. If you provide the signal word/phrase in the sentence, you do not need to include it in the parenthetical citation.

In-Text Citations: As with most source types, Harvard referencing uses a standard author-date format for in-text citations of magazines and newspapers. The important thing here is to check whether the article has a named author. If it does, use the author's name in your citation alongside the year of publication.

### Harvard Referencing - How to Cite a Newspaper Article

Complete the reference with the source information. In this case, it would be the newspaper title and the page numbers the article appears on. For the newspaper title, capitalize all major words in the title, and be sure to italicize the title. After the newspaper title, add the page number the article.
