Africa's early enthusiasm for a permanent International Criminal Court Professor Jalloh maintained that African States initially saw the ICC as part of the solution to the problems regarding international crimes. Thus, they embraced the ICC idea, joined it in large numbers, and referred situations to its prosecutor for investigations.

Historically, realpolitik, self-preservation and geopolitics have marred international criminal justice, and Africa's relationship with the West is steeped in humiliation making some African rulers suspicious of Western-dominated institutions. The perception that the ICC dispenses lopsided justice stems from this history.

What is clear is that there is a crucial split between the AU, on the one hand, and its members, on the other, concerning the way forward. Given the lack of support from African states for establishing the ICL, the ICC remains the only court providing international criminal justice in Africa.
