The Jaeger chart is an eye chart used in testing near vision acuity. It is a card on which paragraphs of text are printed, with the text sizes increasing from 0.37 mm to 2.5 mm. This card is to be held by a patient at a fixed distance from the eye dependent on the J size being read. The smallest print that the patient can read determines their visual acuity.

The Jaeger Eye Chart is a reading and testing chart used by optometrists and ophthalmologists to determine if a patient is nearsighted, and to what extent. Different excerpts of a text are listed in numerical order, corresponding with the size of the text printed beside it. The number 1 is the smallest text and 11 is largest.

Sit or stand 10 feet away from the eye chart. For a normal Snellen chart, the distance at which you read the chart is 20 feet but the chart you have printed is smaller in size. The size of letters on your chart at ten feet is the same as the size of letters on a normal-sized eye chart at a distance of 20 feet. Cover your left eye with your palm.

Reading tests have been used since before the Middle Ages to test the function of the eye. Major changes started to occur in the middle of the 19th century. In 1843, Kuechler, a German ophthalmologist in Darmstadt, wrote a treatise advocating the need for standardized vision tests (6). He developed a set of three charts, to avoid memorization.
