When the War of 1812 began, Kentucky had a total population of only 400,000 and out of this total furnished 40 regiments of volunteer militia, as well as a number of battalions and companies, i.e. more than 25,000 men between 1812-1815. Of the 1,876 Americans killed during the war, some 1,200 or about 64% were Kentuckians.
