The regulations state that medication administration is a nursing act. Nursing acts can be delegated by an RN to someone who they approve as being prepared and qualified. In DDA-licensed programs, the qualified person must be a Certified Medication Technician (CMT), who has completed a DDA-approved medication technician program.
