These types of macros are generally referred to as user interface macros. Access 2010 was the first version to introduce the concept of data macros. A data macro allows you to automate tasks and add functionality directly to your tables. Data macros and their actions are attached to specific table events such as when you add a new record to a table.

When a database starts, Access runs the AutoExec macro before it runs any other macros or VBA code. Create an AutoExec macro. If you have already created a macro that contains the actions that you want to occur when the database starts, just rename the macro to AutoExec, and it will run the next time that you open the database. Otherwise, follow these steps to create a macro: On the Create tab, in the Other group, click Macro.

Create a macro that runs when you open a database - Access

If you name a macro Autoexec, Microsoft Access automatically runs it when your database opens. You can also open Microsoft Access from a command line and specify a macro name after the /x switch to run it when it opens. For instance, you can run the macro named MyMacro like this:

Convert macros to VBA code. You can use Access to automatically convert macros to VBA modules or class modules. You can convert macros that are attached to a form or report, whether they exist as separate objects or as embedded macros. You can also convert global macros that are not attached to a specific form or report.

On the Create tab, in the Macros & Code group, click Macro. Access opens the Macro Builder. On the Quick Access Toolbar, click Save. In the Save As dialog box, type a name for the macro, and then click OK. Continue with the section Add actions to a macro.

Create a user interface (UI) macro - Access

When you record a macro, the macro recorder records all the steps in Visual Basic for Applications (VBA) code. These steps can include typing text or numbers, clicking cells or commands on the ribbon or on menus, formatting cells, rows, or columns, or even importing data from an external source, say, Microsoft Access.

When you choose the Macro button on the Developer tab, it opens the Macros dialog box, which gives you access to VBA subroutines or macros that you can access from a particular document or application. The Visual Basic button opens the Visual Basic Editor, where you create and edit VBA code.
