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My Gum Is Gone

Receding gums are a condition in which your gums begin to recede away from the surface of your teeth, sometimes due to a loss in gum tissue. It's almost always a consequence of long-term poor oral health, although people with diabetes and other immunological conditions are often at higher risk of receding gums and other periodontic disease. It can cause tooth mobility, tooth loss, and cavities below the gumline.

I have lower dentures but I have no gums for the dentures to hook to so I have been told I would do better by getting dental implants because my dentures come undone and move around in my mouth all the time.

I have lower dentures and no gums: what are my options?

I completely understand the concern, however there are many causes for gum recession. The first is periodontal disease. If your gums are infected

due to lack of poor hygiene, then the gum tissue would weaken and recede over time. In this situation, you need to visit the dentist for scaling and root planing as well as local antibiotic placement. Other factors causing gingival recession could be faulty toothbrushing technique, excessive toothbrushing, tooth malposition and abnormal frenum ...

My gums are disappearing very quickly. What can I myself ...

A common adult gum problem is gum recession. Gum recession is when the root (or cementum) of the tooth becomes exposed as the gum line pulls away from its original attachment. This could be a result of gum disease as the jawbone surrounding the teeth is lost. Wherever jawbone is lost, gums will follow, and this exposes the root of the tooth.

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
