Neonatal And Pediatric Critical Care

In 2018, CPT amended the guidelines to allow for different specialties within the same group to provide critical care services to neonatal and pediatric patients. Initial-day critical care codes are reported only once during an admission for a patient younger than age 6 years. If the patient still requires critical care on the 29th day of life during the same hospital stay, the pediatric subsequent critical care code 99472 is reported.

If a provider from the same group or specialty rounds on the patient later in the day, he or she cannot bill another critical care code for a patient younger than 5 years of age. The applicable code sets include: Neonatal critical care 28 days or younger
