The Psychological Capital Questionnaire is an introspective psychological inventory consisting of 24 items pertaining to an individual's Psychological Capital, or positive psychological state of development. The PCQ was constructed by Fred Luthans, Bruce J. Avolio, and James B. Avey with the goal to assess the dimensions of PsyCap. The PCQ measures four dimensions of PsyCap: hope, efficacy, resiliency, and optimism. The PCQ takes between 10-15 minutes to complete and can be administered to indiv

We hypothesized a strong positive association between the PCQ and our newly created measure (Compound Psychological Capital Scale- 12; CPC-12), a higher positive correlation between general self-efficacy and the CPC-12 compared to the PCQ and a lower positive one between occupational self-efficacy and the CPC-12 compared to the PCQ due to the domain specific traits of the PCQ.

PsyCap is moderately and negatively related to stress and turnover intentions, such that people who are higher in PsyCap are likely to report lower stress and lower intentions to leave the organization.
