Nursing documentation clearly describes: An assessment of the clients health status, nursing interventions carried out, and the impact of these interventions on client outcomes: Information reported to a physician or other health care provider.

Your Medical Documentation Matters

Document the reason why the client refused...this is a good time to use the client's own words in quotations. • If you don't give a medication, circle the time and document the reason for the omission. • Chart client's subjective data (what the client perceives and the way they express it) by directly quoting it.
