Introduction. Rich Text Format (RTF) is a specification used by common word processing applications, such as Microsoft Word. When you save a document, RTF is a file type option that you select. BI Publisher's RTF Template Parser converts documents saved as the RTF file type to XSL-FO. You can therefore create report designs using many of your standard word processing application's design features and BI Publisher will recognize and maintain the design.

B Appendix: Designing RTF Templates. This appendix provides instruction and best practices for the creation of the Rich Text Format (RTF) templates that form the basis of reports. The recommended method for creating RTF templates is using the Oracle BI Publisher Template Builder plug-in for Word. This appendix provides information on installing the plug-in, along with guidance and examples for building templates for different types of reports, using the core Brand Compliance style.

### Appendix: Designing RTF Templates - Oracle

RTFTemplate integration. Before integrating RTFTemplate, you must understand generation process of RTFTemplate. Here the two " well practices " to integrate RTFTemplate : XML file of available fields (\*.fields.xml) must be used while the merge of the JAVA context with RTF model. When you want integrate RTFTemplate, you must use this file to know informations about each fields (type list or not) and not the JAVA context.

### User guide - RTF Template

Every custom template or document you create is automatically based on the 'Normal.rtf template' file. This is an external file that provides default styles, numbering and other base formats, such as the default list numbering, MasterList. You can edit the Normal.rtf file to apply your own default styles to the documents and templates you create.

Select Start >Programs >Oracle BIP Desktop >Samples >RTF Templates. b. Open the Balance Letter folder and load the file Balance Letter Start.rtf. This is a sample template file.. The RTF template file opens in MS Word.. To build a report and view the report with data, you must load sample XML data.

### Creating RTF Templates by Using BI Publisher 11g Template ...

You can use most FO elements in an RTF template inside the Microsoft Word form fields. The following FO elements have been extended for use with BI Publisher RTF templates. The BI Publisher syntax can be used with either RTF template method.

### Extended Function Support in RTF Templates

Step 1: RTF model source parsing which load RTF model into the RTFDocument structure. RTFDocument is composed with the whole RTF model, and cut RTF elements of the model, which are interpreted by RTFTemplate as fields (RTFField), bookmarks (RTFBookmark)... A standard file of global document styles, called Normal.rtf, is automatically applied to all new templates you create from scratch; it is possible to edit Normal.rtf to tailor the styles to your requirements, and to override these styles within the template

You use report templates to generate reports on your model that present specific information in a particular format, and to generate those reports repeatedly and consistently. You can select from a range of system templates on the Document Generator, to immediately generate reports from your model. A template consists of:
