The species spectrum of fungi colonizing plates of nutrient agar from soil inocula changed progressively with the degree of staling caused by earlier established fungal colonies. At the highest degree of staling, colonies were produced only by *Trichoderma viride* and three species of *Penicillium*. Tolerance of fourteen species of soil fungi to fungistatic growth products was independently assessed through the growth made by each species on a series of culture filtrates.

Fungi are among the simplest of eukaryotes. Their study has provided useful paradigms for processes that are fundamental to the way in which higher cells grow, divide, establish form and shape, and communicate with one another. The majority of work has been carried out on the budding yeast *Saccharomyces cerevisiae*, but in nature unicellular fungi are greatly outnumbered by filamentous forms ...

A method has been devised for determining the nature of the propagules (i.e. spores or hyphae) that give rise to individual colonies of fungi on soil dilution plates. Soil dilution plates of clear, filtered Dox+yeast agar (pH 4.2-4.4) are incubated for 18 hr. at 25° C, and are then searched for young fungal colonies, each of which is removed in a small agar block for direct microscopic examination.
