APOE e2 — the least common — appears to reduce the risk of Alzheimer's.; APOE e4 — a little more common — increases the risk of Alzheimer's.; APOE e3 — the most common — doesn't seem to affect the risk of Alzheimer's; Genes aren't the only factor. With First CRISPR Trials, Gene Editing Moves Toward the Clinic May 4, 2020 (JAMA) - In March, a patient with an inherited form of blindness called Leber congenital amaurosis became the first person to undergo gene editing inside the body using clustered regularly interspaced short palindromic repeats (CRISPR) and associated protein 9 (Cas9).

While gene therapy has previously been successfully applied to  $\beta$ -thalassemia, through lentiviral transfer of the  $\beta$ -globin gene (HBB) , the concern remains that random integration might result in oncogenesis . Gene editing provides an alternative to viral delivery of intact genes for the treatment of  $\beta$ -thalassemia and sickle cell anemia.
