The geology of Oak Island was first mapped in 1924, which found a composite of four drumlins (two large and two small) forming the Island. These drumlins are "elongated hills" which consist of multiple layers of till resting on bedrock, and are from different phases of glacial advance that span the past 75,000 years.

It was said to resemble dark Swedish granite and to have an olive tinge, and was not a stone common to the area.
