The 'thin red line' was a group of 200 Highlanders flanked by 350 Ottoman (Turkish) soldiers who stood their line about 1 mile north of the town of Balaclava. Because there were not sufficient troops, the 93rd Regiment stood two men deep, which was far less than the four man deep regulation of the time.
