### Transformational and Transactional Leadership ...

Burns describes transforming leadership this way: Such leadership occurs when one or more persons engagewith others in such a way that leaders and followers raise one another to higher levels of motivation and morality. Their purposes, which might have started out as separate but related, as in the case of transactional leadership, become fused.
