The American Psychiatric Association guideline for the treatment of borderline personality disorder represent a committee consensus and take a different point of view. 35 The guideline (page 8) states, "When the patient's safety is judged to be a serious risk, hospitalization may be indicated." Yet there is no evidence that such interventions actually increase safety or reduce mortality.
