The Minidoka Irrigation Project of the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation, created with the passage of the Reclamation Act of 1902, involved the diversion of Snake River water into the Snake River Plain upstream of Shoshone Falls in order to irrigate approximately 1,100,000 acres (4,500 km<sup>2</sup>) in the Snake River Plain and store 4,100,000 acre feet (5.1 km<sup>3</sup>) of water in Snake River reservoirs.

### WDFW FISHING RULE CHANGE: Snake River Spring Chinook ...

That area is upstream of the Columbia and lower Snake River's federal dams. That means that changing the operation of the hydrosystem would not solve the problem, the scientists wrote. At the same time, the disappearance of wild Snake River sockeye populations has eliminated much of their capacity to adapt to environmental changes.
