However, as a guideline, paragraphs should usually be no less than 2 or 3 sentences long and there should be 2 or 3 paragraphs per page of A4. The length of a paragraph depends on the idea being treated, but if a paragraph is shorter than 2 or 3 sentences, check to see if it is not really part of the previous or next paragraph.

For example, you can set a goal of writing four to six sentences per paragraph: in that number of sentences you can announce an idea, prove that idea with evidence, and explain why this evidence matters by linking it to the overall goal of your paper. In the final version of your paper you may have a shorter paragraph or two.

Some writing manuals will direct you to have one paragraph for every point made in your thesis. The general idea behind this rule is a good one - you need to address every point, and you will need at least a paragraph for each.

In order for a paragraph to maintain a sense of unity, the paragraph must focus solely on a single idea, point, or argument that is being discussed. Therefore, the paragraph should not begin to stray and develop new ideas. If you begin to write sentence that wander from the paragraph's main idea, then it is time to start a new para-graph.
